VOLUNTEERS NEEDED to Conduct Interviews

We need a committed team of volunteers to conduct interviews at member agencies of the Food Bank in communities throughout the state. Volunteers should be comfortable interacting with a diverse range of people in terms of age, culture, ethnicity, personality and more. Volunteers are also expected to have basic computer technology skills.

Each month, the Food Bank and its statewide network of member agencies provide food to 53,000 people. This study will offer an in-depth understanding of the people we serve, including their demographics, needs, and challenges. The results of the study will inform the Food Bank's advocacy and public education efforts.

Volunteer Requirements:

- Must be 18+ years of age
- Attend one 3-hour training session
- Travel to program sites to conduct interviews with a team of other volunteers and Food Bank staff
- Follow research guidelines and directions
- Commit to fulfill at least 3 half-day study assignments
